Clear Cache

Browsers frequently cache web pages so that they load quickly when you return to the page. Unfortunately, new content is sometimes not visible to the returning user.

To clear your cache in Internet Explorer:

- Click the **Gear** at the top right labeled Tools.
- Select **Internet Options**.
- Click the **Delete** button under Browsing History.
- Check only the **Preserve Favorites website data** and **Temporary Internet files and website files** boxes (top two).
- Delete.
- A message will pop up when Internet Explorer has finished deleting the selected browsing history.
- Close the boxes.
- You may need to refresh the page by clicking the refresh icon at the end of the webpage url.



To clear your cache in Firefox:

- Click the **3 bars** at the top right labeled Open Menu.
- Select **History**.
- Select Clear Recent History.
- Select only the **Cache** check box.
- Click Clear Now.

To clear your cache in Chrome:

- Click the **3 bars** at the top right labeled Open Menu.
- Select **History**.
- Click the **Clear Browsing Data** button.
- Select only the **Cached Images and Files** checkbox.
- Click Clear Browsing Data.

To clear your cache in Safari:

- In the Safari menu bar, click the **Safari** option.
- Click the **Clear History** link.
- In the Clear drop-down menu, select the time range where you want to clear browsing data.
- Click the **Clear History** button.
