

## Music Scholarship Application

---

Music Scholarships are made to students, who may or may not intend a major or minor in music, in amounts up to \$4,000 annually and are in addition to any academic scholarships. Recipients are required to maintain satisfactory participation in their assigned ensemble each semester that they receive the award and must remain full-time students in good academic standing. Students who will be non-majors are not required to take private lessons but are guaranteed space in applied music studios if they wish to study privately. A major or minor in music requires private lessons.

### Basis for Consideration for Awards in Music

- Completed music scholarship application including two letters of recommendation that address the applicant's work/talent in music
- Evidence of academic achievement
- Résumé detailing musical experience and study
- Audition and interview with music faculty

### How to Apply

1. Applicants for music scholarships must submit their application for admission to the college.
