

Theatre Scholarship Application

Scholarships are made to students, who may or may not intend a major or minor in theatre, in amounts up to \$4,000 annually. Recipients are required to contribute to the theatre production program and are encouraged to develop their ability and strengthen their background by taking course work in the department.

Basis for Consideration for Awards in Theatre

- Completed application including two letters of recommendation that address the applicant's work in theatre
- Evidence of academic achievement
- Résumé detailing theatrical experience and study
- Audition (two monologues of no more than two minutes each of contrasting styles); Portfolio review for Design or Technical Theatre; or Writing sample for or about Theatre for Literary/Criticism
- Interview

The Selection Process

Applicants for institutional scholarships must submit their general admission application by the Early Action II deadline: February 1. They should also complete this scholarship application and submit it by **February 1**.

Those finalists chosen to receive scholarships will be notified by early March, and must accept or decline a scholarship offer by May 1.
