



## **Instructor of Spanish** (non-tenure track)

The Austin College Department of [Classical and Modern Languages](#), invites applications for an Instructor of Spanish beginning in August 2017. The position is full-time non-tenure track with an initial two-year agreement and the possibility of renewal. M.A., ABD, and Ph.D. will be considered.

The teaching load is three courses of introductory and intermediate language courses per semester, plus a January term, with travel immersion courses at least every other year. Candidates must show evidence of native or near-native fluency in Spanish and English. The successful candidate will have a strong commitment to innovative teaching in a liberal arts environment. Evidence of excellent teaching required. The ability to work effectively as a team member within the department is essential. We seek someone who is also interested in fostering outreach activities.
