- I understand that during my H-1B Cap-Gap Extension I must report any change of legal name, residential or mailing address, employer name, employer address, and/or loss of employment to the AC Registrar's Office.
- I understand that SEVP strongly recommends that students do not travel outside the United States during the Cap-Gap Extension.
