



Sara Bernice Moseley Scholarship Application for Presbyterian Students

Austin College Sara Bernice Moseley Scholarships for Presbyterian Students are awarded to incoming students who are members of the Presbyterian Church (USA) and have achieved distinction both in the classroom and in service to others. The Moseley Presbyterian Scholarship is renewable annually as long as the recipient remains a full-time student in good academic standing and is active in ministry or service.

Basis for Consideration

The Scholarship Committee will consider candidates based on the following:

- Active membership in a Presbyterian Church (USA) congregation for at least the past two years
- Nomination/recommendation from a Presbyterian Church (USA) professional (minister or Christian education director), a former or current officer (elder or deacon), or an Austin College trustee or graduate who is a member of a Presbyterian Church (USA) [form enclosed]
- Evidence of academic achievement
- Leadership qualities as evidenced by involvement in church, school, or community activities
- Evidence of service or ministry to others

The Selection Process

Applicants for institutional scholarships must submit their general admission application by the Early Action II deadline: February 1. Applicants should also complete this scholarship application and recommendation and submit it by **February 1**.

Recipients will be notified by the Office of Admission by mid-March and should accept/decline the award offer by May 1.

Through Austin College's Activators program, students have the opportunity to participate in Presbyterian Church youth ministry during their college years. Numerous religious student organizations provide opportunities for spiritual growth and involvement. Many faiths are well represented in the Austin College student body.

About Sara Bernice Moseley

In 1995, the Austin College Board of Trustees unanimously approved the creation of a scholarship program for outstanding Presbyterian students, to honor Sara Bernice Moseley. Mrs. Moseley was a significant member of the Austin College community and a leader in the Presbyterian Church (USA) for decades. A lifelong member of the Presbyterian Church, she served local congregations in many roles before becoming, in 1978, the first woman ever elected moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the USA. She was instrumental in the 1983 reunion of the two major branches of the Presbyterian Church. Mrs. Moseley, whose husband Dr. John D. Moseley served as president of Austin College from 1953 to 1978, remained a beloved and active member of the Austin College community until her death in 2013.
