How to Apply for a Driver's License as an International Student

Documents needed:

- Passport
- I-20
- I-94
- Completed application form
- \$33 payment in cash, check, or debit/credit card (as of Jan 2021)
- Proof of Enrollment (to request from Maridyth Spore, <u>mspore@austincollege.edu</u>)
- Either:
 - o Social security card (if you are eligible for one) OR
 - o A signed "Social Security Affidavit" at the DPS office upon applying
- (2) proofs of residence
 - o Mail from the bank
 - o Utility bill (cable; gas; electric; phone)
 - o <u>NOTE:</u> If you live in a residence hall, your room number MUST be included in the proofs of residence
- (If you own a vehicle) Proof of Texas vehicle registration and insurance for each vehicle

Instructions:

- 1. Take an approved driver's education course and obtain certificate of completion
- 2. Study the Texas Driver Handbook for the written exam
- 3. Gather all required documents
- 4. Book an appointment at a DPS office
- 5. Pass the vision exam
- 6. Pass the written and practical driving exams

Important notes:

- You must wait a minimum of 30 days after arrival in the U.S. to apply for a driver's license
- If you a have a car, you must also register it with the Austin College Campus Police
