Handle the Health Forms

Austin College requires all enrolled students to have valid health insurance. Every year, all students must go to **Academic Health Plans** and either "Enroll" or "Waive" enrollment. Waiving requires that students upload a picture of their current insurance information for verification no later than July 1, 2021. Be sure the front and back of the insurance card is uploaded on the waiver form.

If students do not complete the waiver, they will be enrolled in the student health insurance and the cost is added to their Austin College student account. The cost of insurance, covering August 1, 2021, to July 31, 2022, is \$2,297.00



COVID Vaccinations

Students who are vaccinated for COVID should report their status within 30 days of the final dose (one dose for Johnson & Johnson, two doses for Pfizer, and Moderna). Use this secure and confidential site to upload a picture of your vaccination card to **Submit Your Vaccine Record**. Knowing the percentage of vaccinated students, faculty, and staff helps with planning health and safety protocols for Fall Term 2021. Although vaccination is not required at this time, it is encouraged.



Financial Matters

Annual tuition payment plans for the upcoming 2021-2022 academic year are available now. These plans offer you the ability to spread out your payments over a longer time period. For full details and contact information, please visit the **Business Office page** of the Austin College website.
