Another Important Health Issue



All students are required to have health insurance coverage while at Austin College. If your student is covered by your policy, they must waive the insurance provided by the College. This is an annual "to do," and applies to all students. No action is required if you are electing the policy offered by the College.

The annual premium of \$2,297.00 will be added to tuition billing unless you go online and complete the Online Waiver Form by August 27. That's TOMORROW.

This charge cannot be reversed after August 27. Proceed to the **Student Insurance page** on the Austin College website for complete instructions.
