 CDC Guided Direction for STUDENTS who Test Positive or are Exposed to COVID-19

If you test positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)	AUSTIN COLLEGE POLICY for Students
Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Isolation away from all campus activities 5 for days (positive date is Day 0). • No trips out of your residence and no visitors. Meals delivered. • Isolation period to include last 24 hours no fever without fever meds and improving symptoms. • Stay separate from roommates or family. • Follow up with Health Services for your clearance date <i>before</i> returning to campus. health@austincollege.edu • Health Services will notify professors and work study supervisors. Students must contact professors regarding missed class or coursework. • After clearance, continue to mask around others for 5 additional days. • After clearance, pick up meal and eat in room for 5 days. <p><i>If you have a fever, continue to isolate until your fever resolves.</i></p>
If you were exposed to someone with COVID-19	AUSTIN COLLEGE POLICY for Students
If you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have been boosted 7 days prior to exposure with documentation on file. OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tested-positive within the past 30 days with documentation on file. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Quarantine needed unless symptomatic. • Notify Health Services. health@austincollege.edu • Wear a mask around others for 10 days. • If on meal plan, pick-up meals, no eating in Dining Hall for 10 days. • COVID-19 PCR negative test on Day 3, or as soon as possible thereafter, to continue to be active on campus. • Day 0 is the day of exposure. <p><i>Monitor for symptoms for 14 days. If you develop symptoms, quarantine away from others and contact Health Services.</i></p>
If you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months with documentation on file. (and not boosted) OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed the primary dose of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months with documentation on file. (and not boosted) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No Quarantine needed. • Notify Health Services. health@austincollege.edu • Wear a mask around others for 10 days. • If on meal plan, pick-up meals, no eating in Dining Hall for 10 days. • Test on Day 3, or as soon as possible thereafter, to continue to be on campus. • Day 0 is the day of exposure. <p><i>Monitor for symptoms for 14 days. If you develop symptoms, quarantine away from others and contact Health Services.</i></p>
If you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Are unvaccinated or have no documentation on file. OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted. OR <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed the primary dose of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quarantine. • Notify Health Services. health@austincollege.edu • Stay home for 5 days in your current residence unless otherwise released by Health Services*. • No trips out of residence and no visitors for 5 days. • If on meal plan, pick-up meals, no eating in Dining Hall for 5 days. • Health Services will notify professors and work study supervisors. Students must contact professors regarding missed class or coursework. • *For clearance by Health Services to return to any campus activities, you must have a COVID-19 PCR negative test on Day 3, or as soon as possible thereafter. You may be released after the negative test, pending evaluation by Health Services. • Day 0 is the day of exposure. • If you live with a test positive person and unable to quarantine, your quarantine or return-to-campus test date may be adjusted. <p><i>If you develop symptoms, stay quarantined and contact Health Services.</i></p>
