Homecoming Court Elections All organizations nominating an individual for the Homecoming Court receive 10 spirit points. Organization nomination forms will be sent via email on **Monday, October 10**th and are due by **Noon on Friday, October 14**th. Student Life will receive a copy of your submission. A. Candidates

- 1. Any charted organization can enter a member of its organization as a candidate for Homecoming Court. The candidate can be whomever the chartered organization decides as long as the following requirements are met:
- 2. All candidates must be of **junior** or **senior** class standing. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 and good disciplinary status are required.
- 3. Nominations from organizations must be submitted **online** by **Noon on Friday, October 14th** in order to appear on the ballot.

B. Court Selection

- 1. The official Homecoming Court will be selected by a two-ballot procedure and an email with ballot information will be sent to all students.
- 2. The first vote will take place on Wednesday, October 19th and Thursday, October 20th online. You have until October 20th midnight to submit
- 3. The top six candidates who receive the most votes will make up the 2022 Homecoming Court.
- 4. The second vote will take place on Monday, October 24th & Tuesday, October 25th online. You have until October 25th midnight to submit.
- 5. A run-off election will be Wednesday, October 26th online if necessary.

C. Campaigning

Candidates may not campaign in any form nor at any point during the election process.

D. Obligations

- 1. All members of the Homecoming Court must be available for the Pep Rally on Friday afternoon for the announcement of the court.
- 2. All members of the Homecoming Court must be present at the football game on Saturday afternoon in order to be presented at half-time.
