



ASSISTANT PROFESSOR OF ECONOMICS

The [Department of Economics and Business Administration](#) invites applicants for a Tenure-Track Assistant Professor of Economics beginning August 2023. We seek candidates with a strong commitment to undergraduate teaching. This position will focus on principles of economics courses, intermediate economic courses, and electives relevant to departmental needs. A successful applicant will teach three (3) courses per regular semester and a Jan-term course once every two-year period. Participation in college-wide interdisciplinary programs and service is presumed. Ph.D. in economics is required by July 2023.
