The Veterans Onward program at Austin College empowers transitioning service members (TSMs) to address their personal and professional goals as they return to the American civilian community. The program pairs tailored academic degree programs with local internship opportunities to help students develop an action plan centering on future employment in Grayson County



About this Program

Service members in the program will first participate in an internship program which offers civilian work experience through on- the-job training in industries local to the Sherman area. Afterwards, students will develop an educational and vocational action plan with their faculty mentor at Austin College, including creating a directed degree program leading to future employment with industry partners.



About Austin College

Austin College is a four-year liberal arts college on a beautiful campus in North Texas. In the seat of Grayson County, the College is centrally located between Sheppard Air Force base, Red River Army Depot, Dyer Air Force Base, Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Fort Worth, Fort Hood, Macalester Army Ammunition Base, Fort Sill, and Altus Air Force Base.

Grayson County has a strong economy, low cost of living, and is near the DFW metropolitan area. Because of this, Sherman-Denison is an excellent location for TSMs to move to upon discharge.
