Austin College announces plans for a **residence hall modernization project** – a down-to-the-studs renovation of the shower and toilet areas of our traditional residence halls for improved function, form, and ADA compliance.

Work begins this June in Caruth Hall and will continue until the estimated completion in Spring 2024; first one wing, followed by the other. The residence hall will remain open and occupied during construction with carefully planned closures.

Baker Hall renovations begin June 2024, and the work will continue until all traditional residence halls meet a modern standard of excellence. Regular updates will be available on the College website beginning Fall Term 2023.
