Local Construction and Areas of Concern: How to get to Target!

Construction detours are all over Sherman in all directions. Notably for 'Roos, the intersection of Hwy 82 and Hwy 75 will be closed beginning Saturday, August 19, with no published time of reopening. GPS is generally reliable with the frequent adjustments.

To reach Town Center for your move-in shopping, we recommend traveling north from campus on Grand Avenue and crossing over the Grand Ave Bridge. The road name changes to Taylor. You'll continue west on Taylor for 3 lights then turn right (north) on Travis. Continue north to pass over Hwy. 82 and you'll see the shopping areas to the right.
