What's Going on with the FAFSA?

You may have heard by now that the FAFSA has been delayed, and colleges are not expecting to begin receiving FAFSA data until **mid-March**. Current Austin College students can consider waiting a few weeks to complete the FAFSA since financial aid packages for returning students will be processed once spring grades are posted at the end of the semester.

Other points to remember:

- All Austin College students who receive financial aid are required to complete the FAFSA each year.
- If you need any help as you work to fill out the <u>FAFSA</u>, our financial aid team is here to answer your questions. Contact us at <u>finaid@austincollege.edu</u>.
- The FAFSA submission deadline for returning students for the 2024-2025 academic year is May 1.

You can set up a payment plan for 2024-2025 beginning **March 1**. If you select the 12-month plan, payments will begin in April. Get ahead of next year's costs with a payment plan through ACI Payments Inc.

Coming Soon: Emergency Contact Check-up

Each semester, Austin College confirms students' emergency contacts (ICE) and tests our Emergency Alert System.

On Monday, **February 19**, your student will receive an email telling them to review and update their ICE contacts in Webhopper.

On Monday, **February 26**, at 4:30 p.m., the **Emergency Alert System** *test message* will be sent by email, text, and automated phone call to all ICE contacts on record. If you are listed as the ICE contact for your student, you should receive these test messages. If you do not—but are expecting to—please follow up with your student to check their ICE designations.

Healthy Habits = Better Results
