WHAT IS TRAVEL JANTERM?

Travel JanTerm is an opportunity for Austin College students to go abroad with fellow students and an Austin College faculty member to learn unique global topics. These courses are offered mostly in January, although some may be offered in May.

Travel JanTerm courses are part of a larger offering of learning opportunities in January. Students who opt not to travel also have oncampus courses to enroll in for that term. Students are required to complete (3) JanTerm courses before graduation.

Sophomores, juniors, and seniors are eligible to participate in travel JanTerm courses.

Course fee: \$5300 Out-of-pocket: \$300



Ireland (JT*199*F)

Course fee: \$5850 Out-of-pocket: \$715

Course fee: \$3500 Out-of-pocket: \$400



Spain (**JT*199*E**)

Course fee: \$5300 Out-of-pocket: \$750



U.S. (NYC) (JT*199*B)

Course fee: \$2075 Out-of-pocket: \$400

DFW Airport

Course-dependent

- Course fees do not include pocket money estimated by each faculty leader
- Because of price fluctuations, course fees may increase up to \$300
- All communication goes to students (reminders for enrollment, payments, and pre-departure activity deadlines)





REGISTRATION

- JanTerm Expo on April 11th from 11:00AM to 1:00PM in the Wright Campus Center 1st floor hallway
- Registration begins on April 23rd
- Registration process:
 - Student picks up a registration card at the Expo or the Registrar's office
 - Student interviews with the JanTerm instructor
 - Instructor and mentor sign the registration card
 - Student signs Financial Obligation
 Form and pays the non-refundable
 \$250 deposit at the Business Office
 - Student submits deposit receipt and registration card at the Registrar's office
- Each course has an enrollment limit

COURSE PAYMENT

JanTerm course fees will be loaded onto a student's account in late July and are payable through Webhopper in the same way as tuition payments are made.

Payment for travel JanTerm course fees will be due:

1 st half	Mon, Sept. 2 nd
Remaining half	Wed, Oct. 2 nd

Students who do not complete payment by the deadlines may be withdrawn from their travel JanTerm course.

In addition to JanTerm course fees, students also need to be in good standing or are current in their account balance.







FINANCIAL AID

- Students who applied for a travel
 JanTerm scholarship have been notified
 via e-mail and/or campus mail
 regarding the result
 - Scholarship recipients must register for a travel course by June 14, 2024
- Travel JanTerm scholarships will be applied towards JanTerm course fees
 - If a student has an unpaid balance from previous semesters in their account, the scholarship will first applied towards that balance
 - Students who received the Stephens scholarship will also have 90% of their out-of-pocket cost covered
- Students can consult with the Financial Aid office (<u>finaid@austincollege.edu</u>) for any additional loan options to cover travel JanTerm costs

SCHOLARSHIPS

A JanTerm scholarship offsets the course fee charged to a student enrolled in a travel JanTerm, which then typically decreases the amount the student owes by the (2) payment deadlines scheduled for JanTerm.

COST	DESCRIPTION
\$4000	JanTerm course cost
-\$250	Deposit
-\$2000	JanTerm scholarship
\$1750	Remaining JanTerm course cost

First half (\$875) due by September 2, 2024 Second half (\$875) due by October 2, 2024



HEALTH & SAFETY

- All students who participate in international JanTerm courses are covered under Austin College's travel emergency insurance
 - Emergency medical expenses
 - Emergency medical evacuation
 - Security and natural disaster evacuation
 - Lost/stolen baggage, travel documents, and tickets
 - Emergency telephone translation assistance
- Medication should be arranged to last the duration of the JanTerm;
 some countries may have restrictions



STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Attendance at all pre-departure orientation sessions hosted by the instructor and/or the Intl. Programs office
- Participation in all course activities unless otherwise noted by instructor
- Communication with instructor about any health considerations that may affect participation in certain activities
- Compliance on instructions and rules put forth by the instructor
- Coverage of most of their meals (unless otherwise noted by the instructor)
- Travel with the group for the entirety of the course
